

## Summer Shortage of TSE Water Mitigation Plan for Landscaping

Dear Resident,

The maintenance and upkeep of the landscaped areas in our community will be a challenging task this summer just as in previous years, owing to the soaring temperatures and a critical shortage of Treated Sewage Effluent (TSE) Water used to irrigate our vast lawns and greenery.

To alleviate this recurring problem and mitigate the risks, we at Emaar Community Management are pursuing various alternative solutions such as irrigation through tapping points, additional water supply using water tankers and employing upgraded irrigation networks and systems.

In addition to this, we are working with the concerned local authorities to ensure a substantial and steady supply of TSE Water from their network.

Over the next few months, you will notice significant efforts undertaken to ensure that the landscaping in your community does not get affected through the various initiatives above. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this period as we work relentlessly to maintain and protect the overall impression and aesthetics of your community.

#### Here are few tips that could help sustain your plants during the harsh summer:

- Water your plants and lawns between 10pm and 6am to avoid evapo-transpiration
- Use anti-desiccants and soil additives to preserve and lock moisture in leaves and the soil, thus avoiding water loss to a great extent
- Install shades and canopies to shield heat-sensitive plants from direct sunlight
