

## Change of Trainers' Policy in Arabian Ranches I & II

### To the residents of Arabian Ranches I & II

Dear resident,

As part of our ongoing efforts to improve the wellbeing of the community, we wish to inform you about a new change in the trainer's policy for Arabian Ranches. The existing trainer's policy will be discontinued from 1 May 2019, and residents shall have the privilege to appoint their own trainers for tennis and swimming.

The change in policy has been introduced due to several requests received from residents to enable them to be trained by the trainers of their own choice. Hence, residents are advised to operate only with trainers certified and recognized by Dubai Sports Council, have appropriate licenses and insurance. Engaging illegal trainers shall be reported and handed over to local authorities, along with the resident engaging them. Trainers are also required to obtain necessary validation and gate passes with an applicable charge from the security gatehouse by submitting the below documents

- Copy of valid trade license of the trainer's company
- Approved training certification/registration from the Dubai sports Council specific to the type of training
- Undertaking of adherence to community rules and no objection letter from the resident, with details of training and trainer.

Further, please be informed that training on Fridays and public holidays is not permitted. Emaar Community Management shall have the right to deny and cancel any bookings made during such days.

We hope that this initiative comes as a welcome move for you and other residents in the community.
